Basic Uses:

Intensive Blend Growing Media is used for vegatated roof systems that require deeper growing media layers, of 8 inches (20 cm) or more. Intensive green roofs are often accessible to the general public and can create a park-like atmosphere.

Packaging:

- Available in bulk by the cubic yard and in supsersacks.
- Each supersack contains approximately 1.5 cubic yards (approx. 41 cubic feet) and weighs approx. 2800 lbs. (1270 kg.).
- 0.75 cubic foot bags (approx. 53 lb. (24 kg.)) are also available at an additional service charge.
- Note: 1 cubic yard = 27 cubic feet.

Protection of Soil Mixes:

Do not deliver or place soils in frozen, wet, or muddy conditions. Material should be at or near optimum compaction moisture content. Do not place materials in excessively moist condition.

When stockpiled, protect soils media from absorbing excess water and from erosion at all times. Do not store materials unprotected from heavy rain. Do not allow excess water to enter site prior to compaction. If water is introduced into the material after stockpiling, allow material to drain or aerate to optimum compaction moisture content.

In handling materials, operating tools and equipment, protect the meda from compaction by laying down planking or plywood as required for protection. Pressure wash equipment prior to handling media to prevent weed seed contamination

Media Mix Placement:

Place Intensive Blend Growing Media with approved equipment and protect all other materials from damage during installation. Pre-settlement: Preset the media by thoroughly watering

Placement of Fill Material:

A. Place Intensive Blend Growing Media directly over the drainage system at specified depth to meet fill and grade shape requirement. Compact at one foot lifts.

- 1 cubic foot saturated (not drained):
 91 to 96 pounds per cubic foot
- 1 cubic foot tamped damp:68 to 72 pounds per cubic foot
- 1 cubic foot tamped, wet and draimed:
 78 to 81 pounds per cubic foot

Construction equipment, other than for compaction, shall not operate on the exposed fill. Over-compaction should be avoided. No foot or equipment traffic shoul be allowed on the compacted material until stabilized surface is placed.
